Ribby Hall SPA Hotel

Facts about the project

Ribby Hall Spa is a Luxury 4 Star Spa Hotel in Lancashire. Set in more than 100 acres of beautiful Lancashire countryside their philosophy is all about being relaxed and indulged.

In addition to the spa facilities, which include a hydrotherapy and aqua thermal spa, and one of the best wet areas in the North West of England, there is a brasserie with two AA Rosettes, champagne bar, gym, and 42 beautifully appointed bedrooms, including two penthouses and 12 suites and in 2013 they won the NEW Luxury Experience Award at the Lancashire Tourism Awards.

When looking for a solution for the corridor areas, where noise was required to be kept to a minimum to enhance the relaxing atmosphere of the hotel, architects Fletcher Smith and Hotel Manager Paul Harrison were keen to include a system which did not compromise the aesthetics, but would meet the acoustic needs.

Using Ecophon's Focus Ds fully demountable corridor system, with a concealed grid ceiling, gave the acoustic requirements whilst also fitting with the look and feel of the hotel.

The hotel maintenance staff were pleasantly surprised at the ease of demounting and re-installing the Focus Ds panels and having a minimum demounting depth of 55mm meant the system could be installed without lowering the ceiling height too much from the services above.





Ecophon absorbers are made of glass wool, consisting of more than 80% recycled household glass. 3RD Technology is utilised in most products meaning that the traditional petroleum-based binder in the glass wool is replaced by a renewable plant-based binder. Waste materials from the company's production are recycled into drainage pellets, EcoDrainTM.
